In 1999, WFI debuted on the NASDAQ Stock Exchange with the 10th most successful IPO in U.S. history.

In 2000, WFI was added to the Forbes 500 of America's Top Companies, the growth-oriented Russell 1000 Index, and was recognized as the 54th fastest growing technology company in North America by the Deloitte & Touche Technology Fast 50, with a five-year revenue increase of 8,443 percent.

Dr. Tayebi and his brother, Masood Tayebi, were also awarded with the Ernst and Young 2000 Entrepreneur of the Year in San Diego; the 2000 American Electronics Association High Technology Industry Recognition Award for telecommunications services; Exporter of the Year by the San Diego World Trade Center, and the 1999 Venture Capital Success Story Award by the San Diego Venture Group.

Dr. Tayebi is also co-founder of Nextreme Ventures, a venture capital firm based in San Diego, and co-founder of BridgeWest, one of Southern California's largest investment companies focused on emerging companies in the telecommunications and Internet space. He is also and Chairman and co-founder of QThink, a provider of semiconductor design services. QThink was voted fastest growing company in San Diego by the San Diego Chamber of Commerce.
